



Mount your device

- 1. Install the bracket to mounting holder.
- Remove the protection plastic film from the suction cup, and position it on the clean windshield.
- 3. Hold firmly against the surface and lock the suction cup lever. The mount will suction and stick firmly onto the surface.
- 4. Lock device on the bracket with bottom on the appropriate socket






Note: Make sure that the device has a clear view of sky to attain best GPS reception.

Dismount your device


- 1. Push the tap on top of the mounting cradle to release the device
- 2. Lift the suction cup lever to easily remove the suction cup from windshield.

Charge the battery


Using the car charger: after vehicle engine is started, charge the device through vehicle 12v cigarette lighter, to protect the device from sudden surges in current.

Note: * Please fully charge the battery (for at least 8 hours) before initial us

- * The battery status indicator glows in red color when charging, and turns green color when charging is complete.
- * Charging time is approximately 2 hours after initial use.
- * It is not necessary to start charging the device before the battery is fully discharged.

Power on your device

Press and hold the power button to turn on your device.

To turn it off, press and hold the power button, and then tap power off icon on the prop-up screen.



GPS Information

Tap the "GPS Info" button on the home screen to enter the GPS information screen, as shown in the following figure.

* To receive satellites signal and position as the right picture. The GPS should be at





outside with a clear vew of the sky.

FM Transmitter

Turn on your car's radio and select a station that has little or no signal reception,

Then tick "Use FM" to enable FM transmitter function. Program frequencies Set your transmitter to the matching station on your car's radio.



Turn on your MP3 player or other device and play a song. Turn the volume to half and raise the car's radio to the desired listening level.

* If FM Transmitter is on, the GPS devices will be no sound.

To let FM transmitter works, the GPS need connect to car charger.

Connection to a PC

Connecting the device to a PC, it will be used as a USB storage device.

Tap "Turn on USB storage" at the right corner to enable the USB storage function. The PC will then disp lay two more disk drives. The first is the storage of the pad, and the second is a removable disk which can be opened only after a TF card has been installed.



Troubleshooting

Take steps described in the tables below to solve simple problems before contacting customer service.

Immediately turn off the device and disconnect the power adapter if the device is not working properly.

Users can't turn on the unit.

- Connect the adaptor correctly.
- Use the adaptor to supply power to charge the battery.

There is no sound.

- Turn up the volume or turn on the sound output.
- Turn off FM transmitter.

The unit cannot receive satellite signals or cannot orient.

- Make sure to use the unit out of room; If in the vehicle, you can use the external GPS antenna to solve this problem

The unit can receive signals now but cannot then; signals received are not stable.

- Use the adaptor to supply power or charge the battery.
- Remove the veil.
- Avoid great swing of the unit.

Safety Instructions:

To reduce the risk of electric shock, don't remove the cover(or back).

The manufacturer should not hold responsibility for the damage caused by any substitutions and modifications of the product without authorization from the manufacturer.

Tor prevent fire or shock hazard, do not expose your device to rain or moisture.

Do not put, store or leave your device near heat sources, in direct strong sunlight, or in a high temperature location.
